The City will buy certain houses and duplexes that have been damaged by the recent flash flood. This is voluntary. This is only for properties that had substantial structural damage, are located in the floodplain, or located where the purchase may benefit infrastructure.

The City will administer a loan program for homeowners that had damage to foundations or to their mechanicals, such as: furnaces, water heaters, sump pumps, general electrical systems. The loan will be a 5-year, interest free loan up to a maximum of \$6,000. The City will also pay the origination fees. The loan is available for any income level to fund recovery for damage caused by flooding.

This grant is for individuals who experienced flood damage and whose income falls below 80% of the median household income. The grant can be used for water heaters, furnaces, and electric panels.
